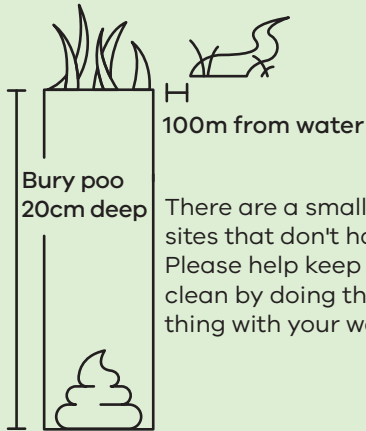
## Protect Victoria's forests



### What to do

- 1 Camp 20m from water to protect riverbanks.
- 2 Ensure you source your firewood legally.
- 3 Clean dishes in a bucket and keep showers and toilets away from waterways.
- 4 Put water on fire until it's cool to touch.
- 5 Bag and recycle glass and cans and collect sharp items.
- 6 Take all rubbish home with you.

100m from water

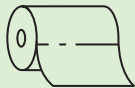
Bury poo

It is illegal to litter, use soap in rivers, or damage trees or bushes. Portable showers or toilets must be set up at least 50m from waterways. Penalties apply for ignoring the rules
